Sub: Allocation of foodgrains under National Programme of PM POSHAN Scheme in schools for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter (01.10.2024 to 31.12.2024) & 4<sup>th</sup> quarter (01.01.2025 to 31.03.2025) of financial year 2024-25.

Sir,

The Administrative Department vide letter No:-Edu-PS/120/2021-11-SED(47103) dated:-08-10-2024 conveyed the allocation of food grains under National Programme of PM POSHAN Scheme in schools for the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of financial year 2024-25 under Pre-Primary, Primary and Upper Primary stages as per the children strength approved by PAB for the financial year 2024-25. Accordingly, the district wise allocation of foodgrains for the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> quarter in respect of districts of J&K UT is made that is enclosed as Annexure-I.

The Chief Education Officers shall further allocate the food grains to the concerned ZEOs immediately by keeping into consideration the closing balance of Sept.2024 and PAB approval of foodgrains for 2024-25, under an intimation to the Food Corporation of India and Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department (FCS&CA). The validity period for lifting of foodgrains will be as per the extant guidelines. Besides this, the parameters laid down by the MoE,GoI for implementation of the PM POSHAN Scheme reproduced below may be adhered to:-

- 1. District authorities shall ensure that fortified rice is lifted instead of raw rice as sufficient stocks are reported to be available with FCI in J&K.
- 2. The Chief Education Officers on receiving the allocation of food grains will send a schedule (periodicity and date/week) of lifting of food grains from the local FCI Depot depending upon the requirement, transportation convenience and storage Capacity.
  - District authorities can lift food grains on monthly, bimonthly or quarterly basis as indicated in the schedule, in accordance with the guidelines issued by Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food & Public Distribution, Govt., of India vide letter No.4-7/2018-BP.II dated 25.04.2019, from the FCI godowns. Districts officers are therefore required to be directed to lift the foodgrains accordingly.
- 4. Payment of the Cost of food grains shall be made by District authorities within 20 days after the receipt of bills from FCI as per the guidelines issued letter No. 1-3/2022-Desk(PM POSHAN) dated: 21.12.2022. The guidelines for decentralization of payments of cost of food grains to FCI at District Level under MDM Scheme can be downloaded from the website of

- the Department of School Education & Literacy(PM POSHAN Division), MoE, GoI. These instructions shall be followed strictly by all the States & UTs.
- 5. Procedure laid down in para 5.5 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 21-12-2022 on decentralization of payment of food grains shall be followed meticulously to ensure that the best quality of food grains, which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ) is lifted from FCI godown. The process followed at the time of receipt of food grains from FCI Depots should be repeated at each level till the food grains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality of food grains is delivered for consumption by children. Records / sample regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.
- 6. As per para 5.3 of PM POSHAN guidelines, a monthly report on off take, payment and payment and quantity of food grains sent to schools/cooking agency may be furnished in the prescribed format latest by 15<sup>th</sup> of the each following month strictly on regular basis.
