The Chief Education Officer (All) shall further allocate the food grains to the concerned ZEOs immediately under intimation to the Food Corporation of India and Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department (FCS&CA).

The parameters laid down by the MoE, GoI for implementation of the PM POSHAN Scheme reproduced below are to be adhered to :-

- 1. The Chief Education Officers on receiving the allocation of foodgrains will send a schedule (periodically and date/week) of lifting of foodgrains to the local FCI depot depending upon its requirement, transportation convenience and storage capacity. The validity period for lifting of foodgrains will be as per extant guidelines and as per the communication 4-2/2022-BP-II(e-379501) dated 02.08.2022(copy enclosed). However, for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2022-23, the foodgrains can be lifted after 02.08.2022 as mentioned in the above communication, as a onetime measure.
- 2. District Administration can lift allocated food grains on monthly, bimonthly or quarterly basis as indicated in the schedule, in accordance with the guidelines issued by Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food & Public Distribution, Govt., of India vide letter No.1-2/2008-BP.II dated 18.09.2008, from the FCI godowns starting from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and up to 25<sup>th</sup> of the last month of the allocation quarter. Districts officers are therefore required to be directed to lift the foodgrains accordingly.
- 3. Payment of the Cost of food grains shall be made by District authorities within 20 days after the receipt of bills from FCI as per the guidelines issued by the MoE, GoI vide letter No: 1-15/2009-Desk (MDM), dated: 10-02-2010. The guidelines for decentralization of payments of cost of food grains to FCI at District Level under MDM Scheme can be downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Education(www.mdm.nic.in).
- 4. Procedure laid down in para 3.6 to 3.9 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 10-02-2010 on decentralization of payment of food grains shall be followed meticulously to ensure that the best quality of food grains, which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ) is lifted from FCI godown. The process followed at the time of receipt of food grains from FCI Depots should be repeated at each level till the food grains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality of food grains is delivered for consumption by children. Records / sample regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.
- 5. As per para 5.4 of PM POSHAN guidelines, a monthly report on off take, payment to FCI and quantity of food grains lifted and released to schools/cooking agency may be furnished in the prescribed format by 15<sup>th</sup> of the each following month strictly on regular basis.
