The Administrative Department vide letter No:-Edu-PS/120/2021-22/(47103) dated:-06-05-2022 conveyed the allocation of food grains under National Programme of PM POSHAN Scheme in schools for the 1st & 2nd quarter of financial year 2022-23 as per the children strength approved by PAB for the financial year 2021-22. The Chief Education Officer's are requested to further allocate the food grains to the concerned ZEOs immediately under intimation to the Food Corporation of India and Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department (FCS&CA). Besides, the parametres laid down by the MoE, GoI for implementation of the PM POSHAN Scheme reproduced below may be adhered to :-

1. District Administration shall ensure that fortified rice is lifted instead of raw rice as sufficient stocks are reported to be available with FCI in J&K.

- 2. The Chief Education Officers on receiving the allocation of food grains will send a schedule (periodicity and date/week) of lifting of food grains from the local FCI Depot depending upon the requirement, transportation convenience and storage Capacity. The validity for lifting of food grains will be as per extant guidelines and as per the communication F.No.4-2/2022-BP-II dated 21.03.2022(Copy enclosed).
- 3. District Administration can lift food grains on monthly, bimonthly or quarterly basis as indicated in the schedule, in accordance with the guidelines issued by Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food & Public Distribution, Govt., of India vide letter No.1-2/2008-BP.II dated 18.09.2008, from the FCI godowns starting from the $1^{\rm st}$ day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and upto 25th of the last month of the allocation quarter. Districts officers are therefore required to be directed to lift the foodgrains accordingly.
- 4. Payment of the Cost of food grains shall be made by District authorities within 20 days after the receipt of bills from FCI as per the guidelines issued by the MoE, GoI vide letter No: 1-15/2009-Desk (MDM), dated: 10-02-2010. The guidelines for decentralization of payments of cost of food grains to FCI at District Level under MDM Scheme can be downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Education(<u>www.mdm.nic.in</u>).
- 5. Procedure laid down in para 3.6 to 3.9 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 10-02-2010 on decentralization of payment of food grains shall be followed meticulously to ensure that the best quality of food grains, which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ) is lifted from FCI godown. The process followed at the time of receipt of food grains from FCI Depots should be repeated at each level till the food grains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality of food grains is delivered for consumption by children. Records / sample regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.
- 6. As per para 5.4 guidelines dated: 10 -02-2010 a monthly report on payment to FCI and quantity of food grains lifted and released to schools/cooking agency may be furnished in the prescribed format by 15th of the each following month strictly on regular basis. A copy of the Monthly Progress Report (MPR) shall be emailed to Mission Director, PM POSHAN Scheme on
